Rode Podcaster Booming Kit

Blue Microphone: Yeti USB

Approximately \$100 – 150. 1 or 2 person recordings. Great quality but also picks up background noise. More versatile than Blue Snowball. [Click here for more info.](#)



Blue Microphone: Snowball USB

Approximately \$70 - 100. 1 or 2 person recordings. Similar to Yeti but cheaper. [Click here for more info.](#)



Logitech B530 USB Headset

Approximately \$40 – 50. 1 person only. Good for entry-level. [Click here for more info.](#)



Zoom H4N Portable Digital Recorder

Approximately \$200 – 300. 1 or 2 person recordings. Portable so recordings can be anywhere, even without laptop. [Click here for more info.](#)



Zoom H1 Portable Digital Recorder

Approximately \$90 – 150. 1 or 2 person recordings. Same as Zoom H4 but without some of the quality and bells and whistles. [Click here for more info.](#)
